



Measures for restaurants, bars and food or drink establishments:

Green-Prevent

- Patrons must be seated; 2m minimum between tables
- Dancing, singing and performing music is permitted, with restrictions
- Karaoke is permitted, with restrictions (including no private rooms)
- Patron contact info is required (one per group)
- No buffet-style service
- Night clubs are permitted only to operate as restaurant or bar
- Line-ups/patrons congregating outside venues must be managed by venue; 2m distance between patrons and face covering required
- Face coverings required, except when eating or drinking only
- Eye protection is required where patrons without face coverings are within 2m of workers*

**This new requirement applies to servers in a table-service environment. Forms of eye protection include face shields, safety glasses, safety goggles, masks with an integrated visor or prescription safety eye glasses. Prescription eye glasses are not acceptable by themselves as eye protection but may be worn underneath face shields, or masks with an integrated visor and may be worn under some types of protective eyewear. Yellow-Protect

Measures from previous levels and:

- Establishments must close at midnight
- Liquor may be sold or served only between 9 a.m. and 11 p.m.
- No consumption of liquor permitted between 12 a.m. and 9 a.m.
- Contact information is required for all seated patrons
- Maximum of 6 people may be seated together (unless from same household)
- Music volume must be limited to no louder than the volume of a normal conversation
- Safety plan must be available upon request

Orange-Restrict

Measures from previous levels and:

- 50% indoor capacity limit, up to maximum of 100 people
- A sign must be posted in a location visible to the public that states the maximum capacity
- Guests seated together must belong to the same household (except patrons who live alone and caregivers)
- Establishments must close at 10 p.m.
- Liquor may be sold or served only between 9 a.m. and 9 p.m.
- No consumption of liquor permitted between 10 p.m. and 9 a.m.
- Screening of patrons is required (e.g., with questionnaire*)
- Strip clubs must close

Red-Control

Measures from previous levels and:

- 50% indoor capacity limit, up to maximum of 50 people
- Outdoor dining, takeout, drive-thru, and delivery are still permitted
- Dancing, singing and the live performance of brass or wind instruments are prohibited

Grey-Lockdown

Measures from previous levels and:

- Indoor dining is prohibited; only outdoor dining, takeout, drive-thru, and delivery are still permitted
